Living with Flowers – Rebecca Law

Rebecca is known for creating large scale immersive installations from the UK to the USA and beyond. Preserved flowers have become the signature of her most recognised works. Individually sewn and suspended, viewers are often invited to navigate through them, discovering the diverse forms, colours, and textures of each specimen.

Paragliding in Nepal and canoeing on the Victoria Nile in Uganda – Joe McCarthy

Joe's talk will be on expedition travelling. Featuring trips to The Victoria Nile in Uganda, a first descent of the last part of the Nile to be navigated by canoe. Then to Mere Peak in the Everest region of Nepal paragliding off the 6,500m peak into thin air whilst taking in views of Everest
